Overview

Road Safety in India

India is one of the busiest countries in the world in terms of road traffic. The automotive industry across the south Asian country became the fourth largest in the world in 2017. Consequently, the threat of road accident injuries and fatalities loom high.

In India, in the year 2019 alone, 1,51,000 people lost their lives in road accidents, with maximum fatalities between the ages 18 and 45.

Proactivity and responsibility at an individual level can help reduce the number of people directly and indirectly affected by road accidents.



Our Initiative

With an aim to create safety for the citizens of India on the road, through awareness and creating a sense of responsibility, Tapas Foundation conducted virtual sessions with expert panels on road safety, in over 21 educational institutions.

The ignorance around road safety is a major cause of negligence. Often, people are unaware of the grave consequences of not following simple safety protocol like wearing a helmet or keeping the seatbelt on when on the road. As part of the initiative Helmet Saves, we reached to students, to break this awareness gap,.
