



In rural Haryana, access to quality educational resources remains a pressing challenge despite rising literacy rates. Students often rely solely on classroom teaching, limiting their exposure to diverse learning materials.

To address this gap, Tapas Foundation, in collaboration with KAI India, launched the Children Library Program. The initiative began with the setup of a fully-equipped, student-friendly library at GSSS Islampur School, Gurugram, Haryana. LOCATION



GSSS Islampur School, Gurugram, Haryana

This school, situated in a semi-urban belt of Haryana, was chosen due to its limited access to extracurricular learning resources. The initiative aims to serve as a model for similar interventions across the region.

- A reading session was organized, where students explored stories and interacted with volunteers and educators.
- Students were encouraged to imagine beyond boundaries, express ideas, and develop a love for books.
- Tapas Foundation facilitated interactive discussions to promote active learning.

Together, we are not just building a library — we are building futures.























