### INTRODUCTION

Roots Across India, an afforestation initiative by Tapas Foundation in collaboration with Bajaj Finserv, concluded with the successful plantation of over 2,00,000 saplings across more than 50 cities in 23 states and union territories. Designed to address the pressing challenges of deforestation, climate change, and urban pollution, the initiative also aimed to inspire a nationwide culture of environmental responsibility.

From the beginning, the project was envisioned as more than a tree plantation drive - it was a movement to spark awareness, dialogue, and action around environmental conservation. By creating awareness about the consequences of environmental degradation and its mitigation among community members, the initiative empowered individuals to become active participants in the fight for a greener future.

A key goal of the initiative was to create inclusive opportunities for public engagement and rural empowerment through the plantation of **2,00,000** trees in diverse spaces such as farming communities, government schools and colleges, hospitals, public parks, and other public institutions. A significant focus was placed on working directly with farmers to integrate fruit-bearing and soil-enriching trees into their agricultural lands, supporting both environmental restoration and livelihood resilience. These efforts were designed not only to improve air quality and biodiversity but also to transform everyday spaces urban and rural-into healthier, more vibrant environments.

As this chapter of Roots Across India concludes, its roots—both literal and symbolic—continue to grow. The saplings planted are just the beginning of a long-term vision to create greener, more resilient communities. Through this report, we not only celebrate the milestones achieved but also reaffirm our commitment to expanding afforestation efforts, fostering community participation, and building sustainable ecosystems that will thrive for generations to come.

# Turning Vision into Reality: HOW WE DID IT

The project was implemented in a structured, multi-phase approach to maximise impact and sustainability.

Plantation sites were carefully selected based on their environmental and social significance, with a special focus on identifying farmlands of willing farmers for agroforestry, alongside urban parks, school campuses, industrial zones, riverbanks, and degraded forest lands.

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Awareness sessions were conducted in schools, hospitals, and communities to educate people on afforestation, climate resilience, and biodiversity.

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Plantation drives were carried out, with more than 2,00,000 saplings planted, including native trees, fruit-bearing plants, and climate-resilient species.

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For post-plantation care, local communities were involved to play an active role in monitoring and maintaining the saplings to ensure long-term survival and growth.

### **OUR REACH**

The project covered diverse landscapes, reaching urban, rural, and ecologically sensitive regions across India, including northern states like Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Delhi, Haryana, Punjab, and Jammu; western states like Rajasthan, Gujarat, and Maharashtra; eastern and central states like Bihar, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, and Odisha; southern states like Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Kerala, and Puducherry; and northeastern India with Assam.



Recognising the vital role of farmers in environmental stewardship, Tapas Foundation worked hand-inhand with communities to integrate tree plantations into agricultural landscapes.

By introducing fruit-bearing, medicinal, and soil-enriching plant species, the initiative enhanced biodiversity, improved soil health, and contributed to long-term ecological stability. These trees not only supported natural regeneration but also added value to

farmland by increasing productivity and offering alternate sources of income.

Farmers received comprehensive support, from the provision of saplings to technical guidance and on-ground assistance, ensuring that plantations were well-suited to local conditions and needs. This approach helped build climate-resilient ecosystems while strengthening rural livelihoods, making the environmental impact deeply rooted in community well-being. In doing so, the project transformed afforestation from a conservation activity into a tool for empowerment and sustainable development.
